## Remembrance Day

Each year the school are invited by the local RSL to attend the community Remembrance Day service. This year Room 1,2, and 8 attended the service whilst the other classes were at swimming lessons.

The Australian Army were in attendance with the Catafalque Party, which makes it such a special and unique experience for all that could be there.

The Year 6 SRC Leaders spoke beautifully in the service and laid a wreath of remembrance along with other community members.

SRC Leaders Speech:

*Harvey: November 11th, Remembrance Day, is the day fellow Australian's remember the brave men and women who have served, and continue to serve our country during times of war, conflict and peace;*

*In particular, the First and Second World Wars, the Korean War, Vietnam War and all conflicts since then in which members of the Australian Forces have participated to give us, and others, freedom.*

*Macy: I will remember the sacrifices of everyone;*

- *The doctors and nurses who tended to the wounded;*
- *The parents who watched their children fight things that they couldn't protect them from;*
- *The children who were too young to understand why their mums and dads wouldn't be home for Christmas;*
- *The teen boys, who were shipped off to fight before they even got a chance at adulthood;*
- *Or the kids who had to grow up too soon so they could take care of their families in the middle of the war.*

*Because they lost so much...and because they gave everything, we thank them. We will always remember.*
