Over the weekend I injured my knee while winning a basketball grand final. I completely ruptured my patellar tendon so there was some urgency to organise surgery which I had yesterday afternoon. Recovery involves 3 months in a massive brace and then around 9 more months of rehab.

My priority over the week was ensuring that students and staff were appropriately supported. Staff have all rallied around each other and Mrs. Bellman has done a magnificent job of leading the way to keep everything running smoothly. Davina will be the acting principal while I'm on leave, and I am thrilled for her to have this opportunity.

We have worked with Rob Knight, our educational director on ensuring school runs effectively while I recover. Initially I will be away for 3 more weeks, and once I'm reassessed by the surgeon I may be able to return to work in some capacity. I or the school will continue to keep you up to date. I genuinely miss all of your children, the staff and interactions with those of you who I've met. This is not an ideal situation but I have complete faith in the professionalism and commitment of our staff, as well as your children's' enthusiastic and positivity towards learning.


